- Current measures first reported in 2013


Student Success Scorecard Objectives


- Make policymakers, local college officials, and elected boards aware of system and college performance in specific areas of effort
- Inform the public about the overall performance of the California Community College system


2014 Student Success Scorecard Results


Indicator	Outcome	2013 to 2014 Change	Comparison to Peer Group Average
1. Career Technical Education completion rate	55%	+4%	+5%
2. Remedial English improvement rate	45%	+2%	-7%
3. Persistence rate	65%		-7%
4. Remedial math improvement rate	27%	-2%	-10%
5. Completion rate	54%		-2%
6. Remedial ESL improvement rate	16%	-2%	-11%
7. Percent of students earning 30+ units	61%	-9%	-9%

Five-Year Comparisons of Student Success Scorecard Indicators













2014 Student Success Scorecard Indicators by Student Characteristics
